Last year from the last day of classes to the end of final exams the following crimes occurred:

20 vehicle break-ins; 27 thefts of unattended property; 2 robberies; and 1 residential burglary;

As you prepare to move out of your residence, please remember to be attentive with your property:

Safety Tips



- When packing your vehicle, lock your residence each time you leave. Do not prop your door open. Valuable items may be stolen easily while you are at your vehicle.
- Lock your vehicle after every trip of loading. Again, valuable items can be stolen easily while you are gathering your items from your residence.
- Avoid walking alone. Utilize Campus Cruiser 213-740-4911.
- Do not leave your property in your vehicle overnight. Many of the vehicle break-ins have occurred when this happens. Even in subterranean garages.
- Lock all of your windows and doors when leaving. Most students are away from their residence for long periods of time during this week.
- Report suspicious behavior and activity to DPS immediately. Trust your instincts. We would rather respond to a call and determine no crime than respond and take a report when we could have apprehended the suspect.
